### Zeppelin Group is the 2022 training champion

The Zeppelin Group will be recognized as an outstanding company again in 2022, and will receive two seals of approval as a top employer. In the large-scale study conducted by the F.A.Z. Institute and the IMWF Institute for Management and Economic Research, Zeppelin achieved second place among Germany's most sought-after employers in 2022. 1,000 companies were compared in the study. For the first time, the Zeppelin Group was able to secure the top spot among 540 other selected companies in the category, as the "2022 Training Champion". Zeppelin's Labor Director and Managing Director Alexandra Mebus responded enthusiastically: "These awards and high rankings show us that we are on the right track. Our personnel measures and initiatives meet the expectations and needs of employees. We will of course continue to work intensively to offer our trainees, employees, partners and customers an optimal environment."
